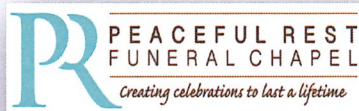

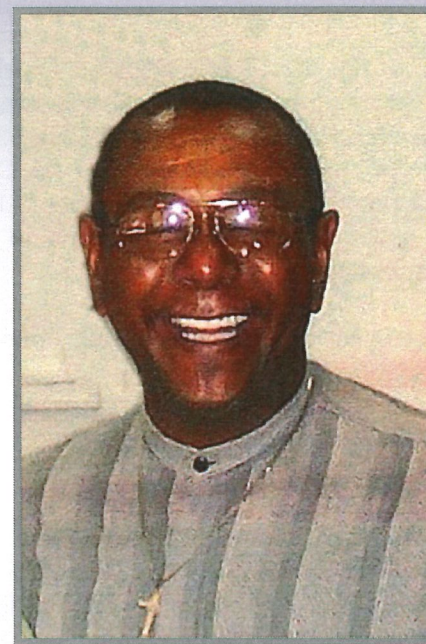

Eddie Lee Saunders went to be with our heavenly Father on Friday, October 21, 2016. Eddie was born on December 4, 1954 in Topeka, Kansas to Emmett L. Saunders and Myron Beaver Saunders.
