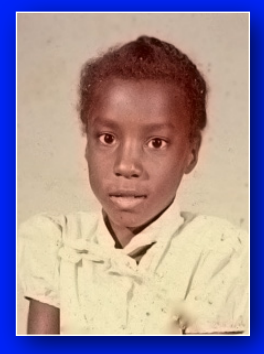


## *A Life of Love ...*

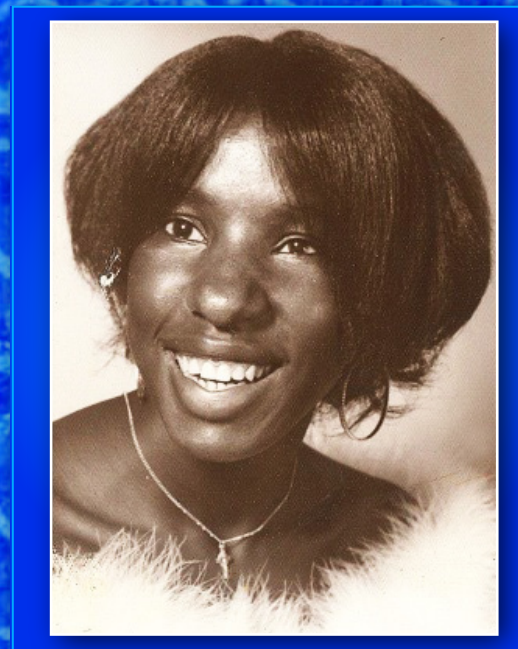
